6. Identify, Classify and Mitigate Risk

- o Identify Risks and Assumptions
- Assign Probability and Impact to each risk
- Prioritize risks and develop appropriate mitigation strategies

This program is designed to help core team members leverage a Best Practice Project Model to effectively manage cost, time and project scope. Team members leverage the Work Breakdown Structure to build an efficient project plan and working with the Project Leader / Manager to control project scope.

Participants will work on a simulated project and deal with all of the challenges common to projects and associated resources. They will experience making decisions, managing relationships / resources, gathering / responding to Voice of Customer and keeping a project on-time and within budget.

This program is also an excellent way for teams to integrate new members and expedite the launch of key projects and leave the program with key early deliverables like Project Charters, work plans (Gantt Charts, draft budgets and resource requirements) and a core team well on its way to effectiveness and efficiency.
